The West Salem Community Garden is taking shape. Six of eight plots have been planted and plants have broken ground from seeds in a number of these plots. Plantings include flowers in the corner plot along with corn, beans, squash, cucumbers, cantaloupes, cabbage, okra, tomatoes, egg plant, ornamental gourds, pumpkins, and watermelons. The garden is being watered twice daily subject to weather assistance. Help is needed to continue this task throughout the growing period.

A short meeting is requested with plot holders and worker helpers on site at Bank and Green Streets for Friday, June 10, 6:30 PM to discuss watering schedules, weeding and any remaining unplanted plots.

Should this garden effort become a success and continue annually, a grant from the Winston Salem Foundation through the Forsyth Agricultural Extension Center is potentially available. The Extension Service has already provided tilling, tomato and pepper plants and various seeds to the garden.
