SE Gateway Project

I am so excited! The big announcement was made Monday. The major missing component to our neighborhood is now officially in the works. A place to shop for the basics, a restaurant, and a synergistic area to gather and see your neighbors.

By late summer 2005 the first phase will be finished with 10,000 sq. ft. of retail and restaurant space. Other phases will follow, including a 92,000 sq. ft. YWCA, a large book store, and a 30,000 sq. ft. specialty grocer. Now we won't have leave our neighborhood to do our basic shopping. Condos over the shops will range from \$100,000 to \$300,000, further enhancing our neighborhood. A big thanks to Tom Callaway, Derrick and Chad Davis, our city government officials and the SE Gateway council for making this soon to be **former** blighted area, a place we can all be proud of.

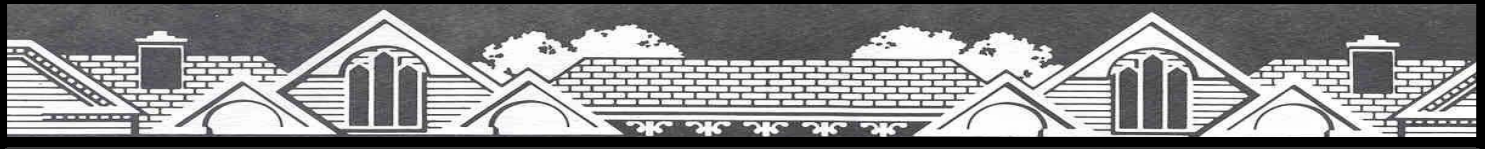
